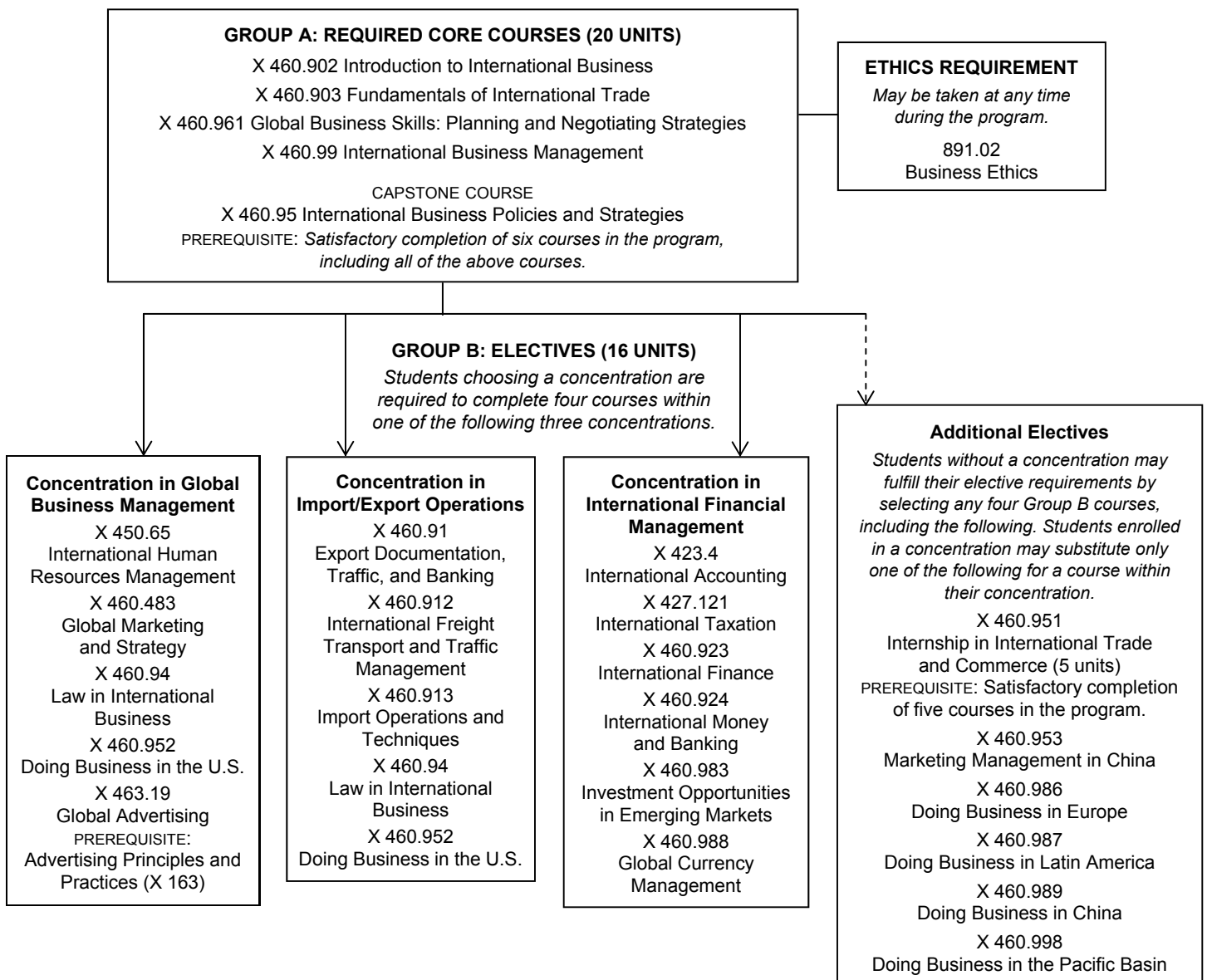


# Certificate in International Trade & Commerce

To grow and stay competitive in the global economy, business professionals in organizations of all sizes—from entrepreneurial companies to large corporations—must have a thorough understanding of the dynamics of international business. The **CERTIFICATE IN INTERNATIONAL TRADE AND COMMERCE** offers a broad and comprehensive curriculum that exposes students to the business, economic,

and political forces dominating the burgeoning international marketplace. Students may complete this 36-unit certificate with or without a concentration. Many of the courses also are offered online.

In addition to the required courses and electives, students must successfully complete the one-day seminar, *Business Ethics*.



**INTERNSHIP**

*Internship in International Trade and Commerce* (X 460.951) provides internship opportunities (when available) for students who have officially enrolled in this certificate program and have completed a minimum of five courses in the program.

**PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS**

All courses to be applied toward this certificate program must be taken for a letter grade; a grade of "C" or better is required. Students receiving a grade of "C-" or lower must either repeat the course or confer with a certificate programs advisor to find a suitable substitute.
